# What is the PIT?

- A census of a community's homeless population based off of surveys.
- Includes:
  - Sheltered count, for Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, and Safe Haven projects
  - Unsheltered count



# PIT importance

- Helps inform Congress of extent of the homelessness problem
- Helps communities plan services & programs
- Provides data over time to track progress

## Strengths

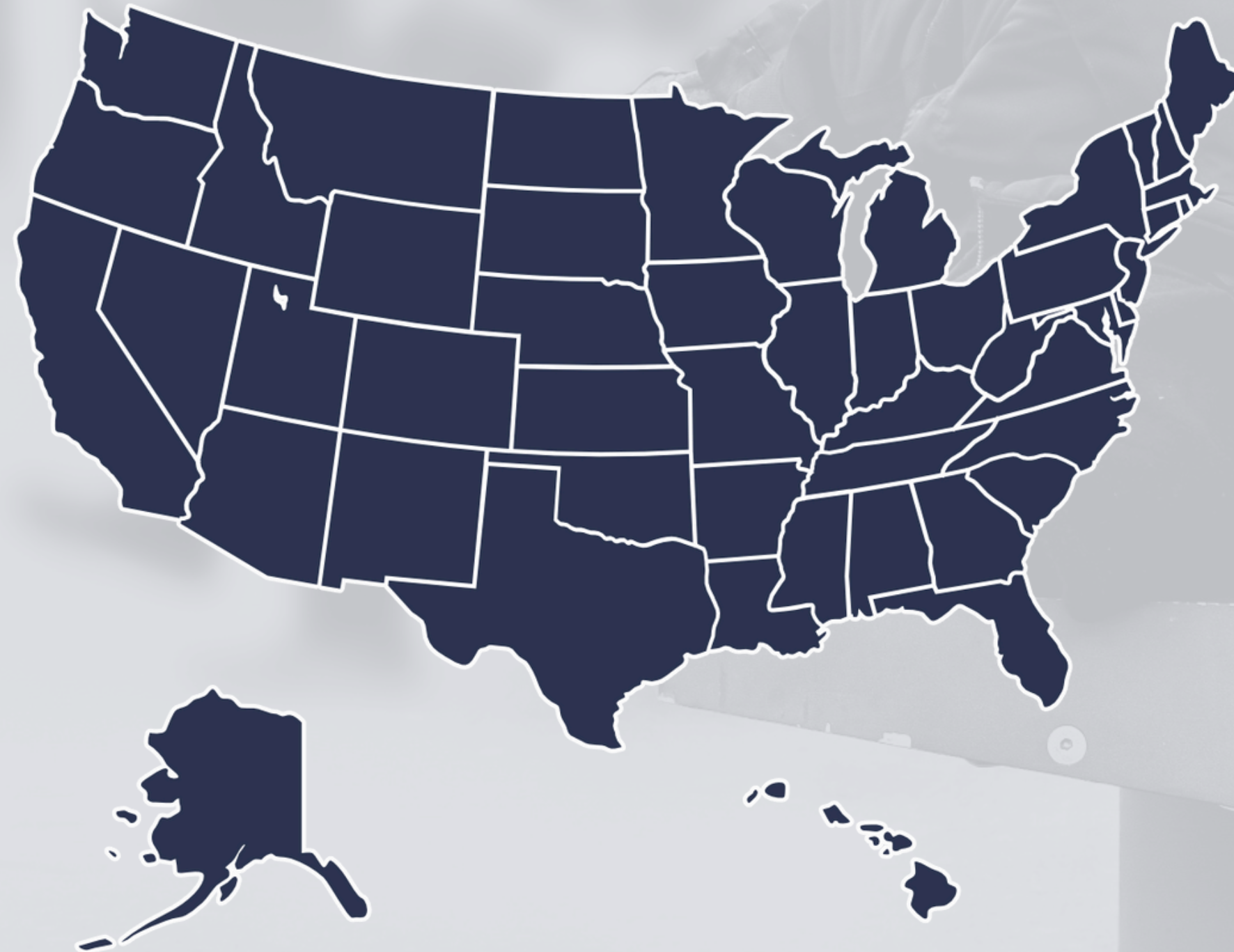
- Includes non-HMIS participating projects

# PIT Strengths/Weaknesses

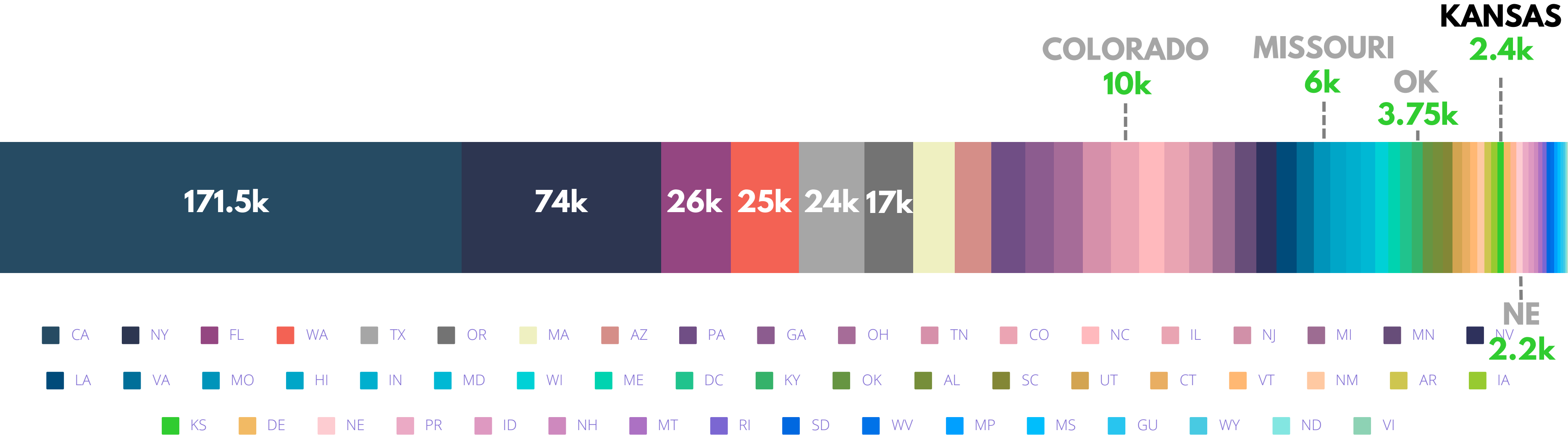
## Weaknesses
